ABOUT THE FARM: Following the riots in 1992, I4 acres of property located in Los Angeles have been used as a community garden by local campesinos (subsitence farmers). The 360 plots make up one of the largest urban gardens in the country, providing much needed food and green space for families in South Central. The police and city of L.A. have used weapons and bulldozers to evict the farm for a planned warehouse facility. The farmers have vowed to fight back, and have called for international support.
