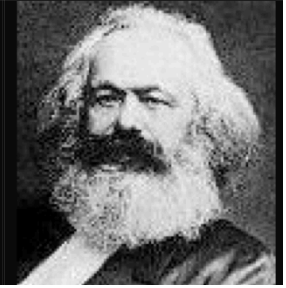

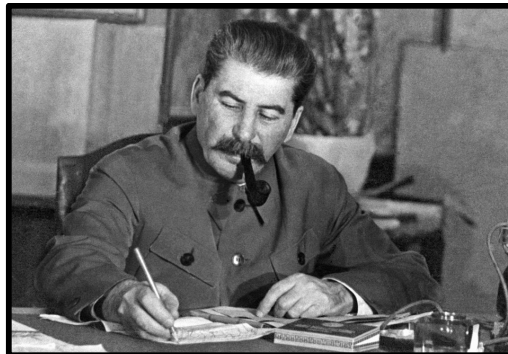


Sunday Morning at the Marxist Library
